The last 3-5 years we have seen far too many drownings, most which could have been prevented with knowledge, swimming/survival skills or just plain common sense. Unfortunately the groups in danger are the very young and the middle age male. We can work with the young, the other group is up to you. Our program talks about being safe around water.

The Grade Six Bike ride has been moved to Thursday 8th December. Notes will come out, and we have been organising support cars, adults and adult riders. Why the focus on Bike Riding at this school? Exercise is something that many of our society do not do a lot of. It enhances BOTH physical and mental wellness, and after the Pandemic, this is a priority. Bike riding is something everyone can do and enjoy, and with the trails around Laurimar, Melbourne and indeed the state of Victoria, it opens up excellent opportunities for great family adventures.
