Yesterday we had a visit from Rob Mitchell MP, the sitting member for McEwen. He brought us some new flags and had a look around our building projects. He has always supported us when we have needed help with government policies affecting us adversely. You will see a picture of him presenting the flags to our First Term JSC members.

I have also published a picture of the visit by Lauren Kathage, the member for Yan Yean. Today I had a visit from the Assistant Regional Director of our Education region. We are very popular at the moment! Putting our school, its great community and brilliant results out there is always good for making sure we are in the mix if something nice is happening.

NAPLAN for Grade 3 and 5 is almost upon us. (It runs across Australia for Years 3, 5, 7 and 9.) It is early this year - by two months - which puts it around camp time. This is not ideal but the dates were changed well after we booked camp and no warning or consultation took place. It is nearly all online; the Grade 3's are still allowed to do their "Story Writing" on paper. It is a way to measure student progress against Australia wide results. We also do this with the standardised testing we mention in student reports. Our results however are at the end of the year and perhaps more meaningful regards that year's work. We also use tests we get to see and make sure are asking the right questions. NAPLAN is cited by Education Departments as a tool for parents to see their child's results and be aware, but they are also used to rate, rank and evaluate schools. We generally do well in them, as we believe if you teach engagingly and effectively, the test results take care of themselves. If you have an issue with the NAPLAN, you have the option to opt out for your child. Please contact me if you have any questions, concerns or issues, or have a talk with your classroom teacher.


