Thank you to all the parents and carers who attended our Parent Teacher Interviews. On Wednesday evening we were treated to a wonderful Music Recital in the library. Our junior students, supported by a few of our more experienced senior students, put on a fantastic performance. It was especially pleasing to see so many of our Grade 1, 2 and 3 students so engaged and enthusiastic about our music program. along to ensure the program ran smoothly.

Tomorrow at 1:00pm, on the final day of Term, we will be holding a soft opening of our new building. A short ceremony will take place on the basketball court, with a few formalities to mark the occasion. 
Our Concert is on Tuesday, 28th October 6.30pm.






